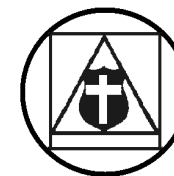
Registration

Financial Assistance

If you are requesting financial aid, check the box on the registration form. **Financial Aid requests will not be processed without the registration form and deposit.** Our funds are limited, and you will be notified as soon as possible as to the amount of aid you will receive. Financial aid is designed to supplement camp fees, and each recipient will be required to pay a minimum (likely 2/3). Many parishes have funds available to assist with camp costs, so please inquire, they'll be glad to support you!

Camp Saint Francis a week long overnight camp hosted for campers ages 8-13. Camp is held at Saint Dorothy's Rest, a retreat center operated by the Episcopal Diocese of California. This site is located in Camp Meeker, California (close to Occidental). The setting is in a dense redwood forest within hiking distance of the Pacific Ocean. Campers are transported by bus between camp and the Church of the Resurrection, in Pleasant Hill, California.

All Meals and snacks are prepared at camp by our volunteer staff. A certified First-Aider is in camp. This is in addition to a lifeguard who is certified for water and swimming program. And just in case, there are medical facilities available in nearby Occidental, Sebastopol, and Santa Rosa.

Camp Saint Francis offers your kids a week of exploring and learning, trying new and exciting things among some of the world's oldest living creatures. From the sun's dawning through the Redwoods above, 'til day is done and "Taps" is sung, campers are encouraged and accepted as they take on new challenges and build lasting friendships with the rest of the camp family each day.
